

MIRACLE OF SCIENCE BAR: ALUMINUM SIGN

Kimo Inc. was hired to design and fabricate light fixtures, hardware and the primary sign for the Miracle of Science Bar and Restaurant. The bar is located on Massachusetts Avenue near the MIT campus and uses the dynamic appearance of the modestly-scaled sign to attract customers.

The design of the sign is based on an image of an atom with electrons orbiting around a nucleus. The aluminum elements were hand bent and carefully fitted to create a curvilinear framework to support the letters. The letters were then hand-cut and mounted on the frames.
